Head Teacher's comments

The new term is now well underway. Thank you for your support last Thursday. Gas was smelt at about 11.30am. As a precaution the school buildings were evacuated and the Gas Board informed. A gas leak was detected in infant boiler. The children were taken to the Ley Inn. The staff there were amazing. They provided warmth, toilets and water for the children including chips for those who had not been collected by 1pm. We cannot thank them enough for their kindness. The boiler was repaired on Friday.

The archery and cheer leading clubs are proving to be very popular. There are still places available for Y1/2 drama club on a Wednesday morning. Premier Education are providing these clubs throughout the year. These will change every half term providing the children with a wide range of opportunities. As part of the sports grant the school has bought into a package with Premier Education to provide PE in the curriculum. This also includes the three clubs per week. The income from the clubs comes directly back into school funds thus reducing the cost of the package. If the activities are fully attended there will be almost no cost to the school for this sports provision.

A school uniform bank is being set up alongside the food bank in Bamber Bridge and Chorley.
