#### Head Teacher's comments

We are concerned by the number of requests that have been made this for for holiday leave in term time . Taking a child out of school in term time will affect their schooling as much as any other absence and we expect parents to help us by not taking children away in school time. There is **no** automatic entitlement in law to take leave during school time.

All applications for leave must be made, in advance, by the parent of residence using the 'Request for leave of absence' form, available from the school office or website. Attendance Policy states that there is no automatic entitlement in law to take leave during school time. Leave in term time will not be agreed at any time unless circumstances surrounding the request can be evidenced, by parents, to be exceptional. Therefore, parents are advised to provide school with any relevant information regarding their request at the point of application if they believe the circumstances are exceptional. Information provided after a decision has been made may not be considered. The Attendance Policy is on the school website or a hard copy can be obtained from the main office.
