# PARENT PAY

Dinner money can now be paid on Parent Pay.

Please note that when an item is added to the payment list on Parent Pay, it will be added against all children's names, this is due to not knowing who wishes to do the club. If your child is not going to use the item, then please just ignore it. The item will disappear when the item is no longer valid.

When paying by vouchers for Care Club, Mrs Seers has to put the payment on manually against the child. She only does this once the payment shows on the bank statements. The bank statements arrive in school around two weeks behind the present date. This may make the amount owing slightly out of sync to what parents think they owe.

If you have not yet signed up to Parent Pay, please try and do this as soon as possible. If you require your username and password to register please contact the school office.

Please note dinner money is now on Parent Pay, if you wish to use this option please do so but school it still accepting cash and cheques. If your child does not have school dinners please ignore the item. If there are any discrepancies please let the office know and they will rectify them.

### Sun Tan Lotion

Now that the hot weather has returned, please remember to send your child into school with a reusable water bottle. Please remind children to refill them during the day.

Also, please send children with a hat that they can wear at break times and lunch times.

It would help school if parents used the once a day sun tan lotion on their children before coming in to school. This will protect the children whilst in school and also stop children having to apply the sun tan lotion themselves.

# Attendance & Punctuality In School

Week 17/06/19 to 21/06/19 - **28** children arrived after 8.50am

School starts at **8.50am**, children should be in class and ready to work by this time.

## Some interesting facts and information to think about:

If your child arrives on time to school they get chance to have a few minutes talking to their friends in the corridor and then can settle into class ready to learn.

If your child arrives late, after 8.50am, they are flustered because they are late, some don't like to walk into class after everyone

has already sat down. If each morning at 8.50am the class does the same type of learning, for example reading and your child walks in at 9am they will miss that piece of learning each day. This will impact on your child's learning.

A child arriving late also impacts the learning on the children who arrived on time, as when a child arrives late the teacher has to go over what they have missed and is then repeating the information to the rest of the class.

If an employee arrived 10 minutes late each day would the employer let them keep doing this.

10 minutes each day x 5 days = 50 minutes x 38 weeks = 31 hrs 40 mins

- Missing just 10 minutes of school a day is the same as missing two weeks over the school year.
  - 90% attendance is equivalent to missing 100 hour long lessons.
- If you take your child on a 2 week holiday in term time, attendance for the year immediately drops to 95%.

- 90% attendance means  $\frac{1}{2}$  a days absence each week; 4 weeks over the year & half a years absence over 5 years!!!!
- 90% attendance is equivalent to a full month off school in a year.

### Did you know?

- Around 85 million days are lost to absence each year.
- A 2 week holiday in school time means your child has approximately 50 hours of missed work to catch up on!!!

Just some interesting facts regarding punctuality and attendance. Although we aim for 100% attendance, each year we set a target for attendance and this is used to compare us to other schools nationally.

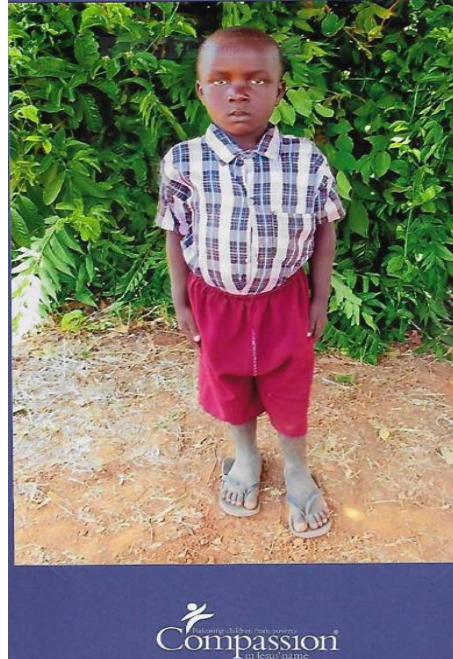
Clayton-le-Woods attendance for the last school year was 96.54%, Spring term it was 96.33% and the last half term was 96.25%. Our target this year for attendance is 97.5%.

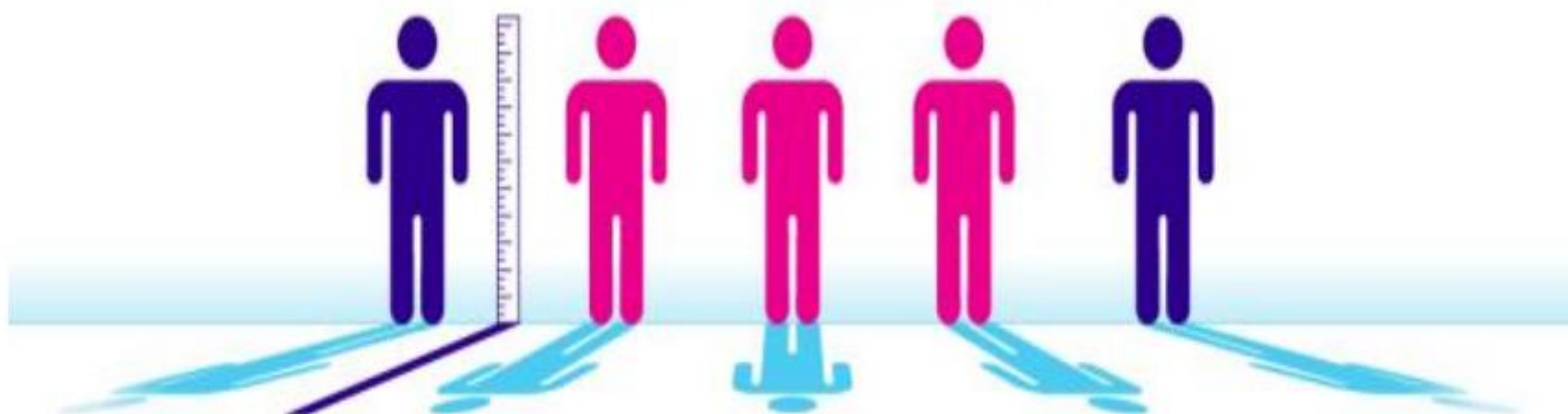

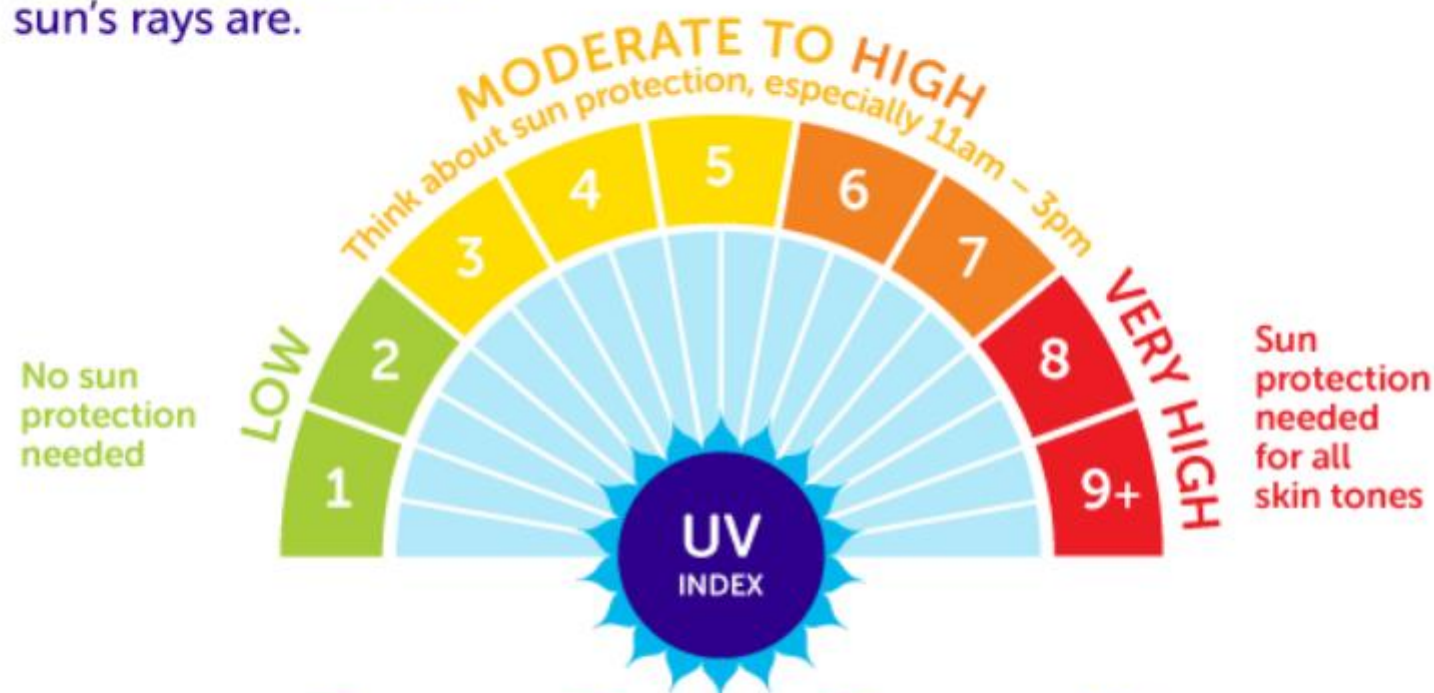
