Please can we ask that you follow the one way system that is in place and do not walk up the driveway to pick up children.

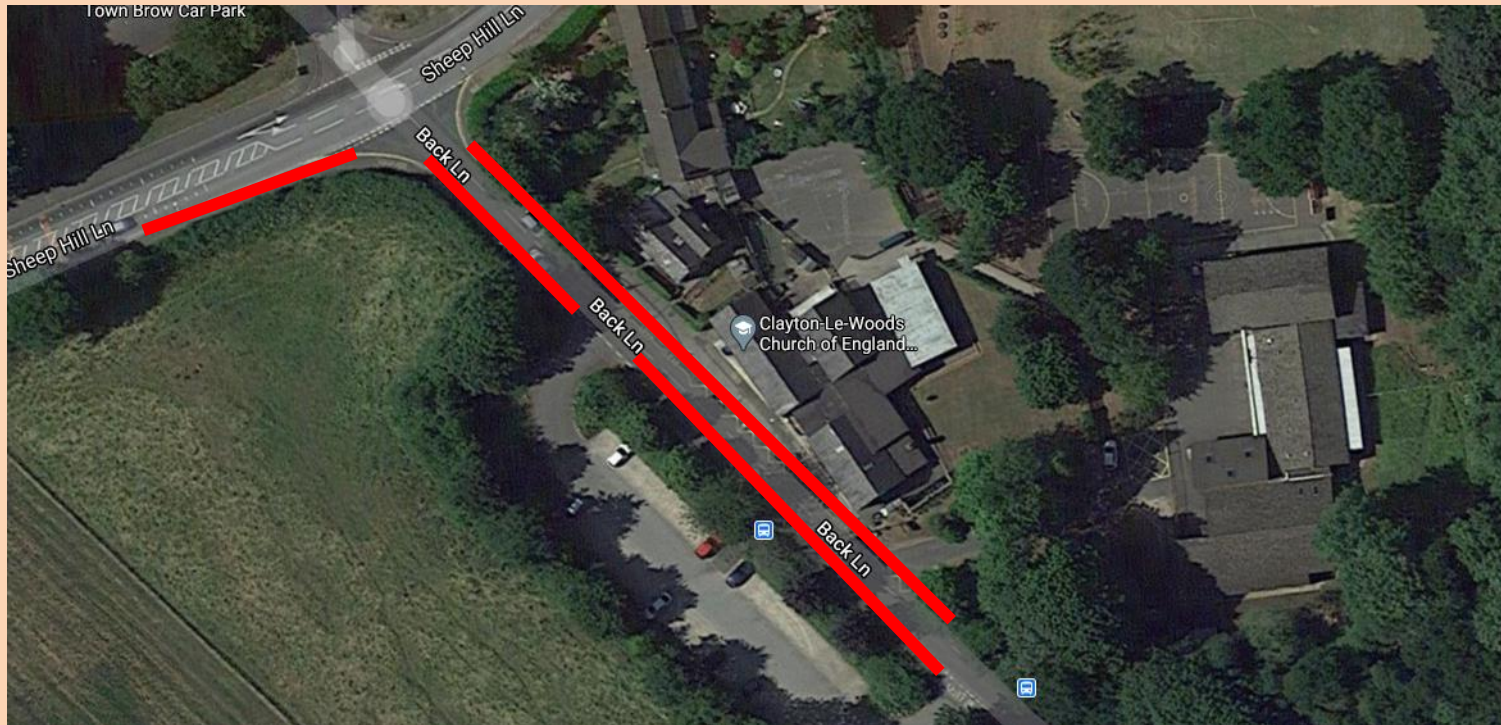
