March 2021: Changes at a Glance

School Uniform		School uniform is compulsory including school shoes (not trainers) unless it is your child's class PE day. This does not need to be cleaned more regularly or any differently to normal.
Rucksacks		Book bags are permitted but we cannot allow rucksacks, due to limited space for storage.
Book Bags		Book bags, which are flat and can be stored easily, are permitted. These will carry your child's reading book and a healthy snack (for Years 1 to 6 - this is optional in key stage one as children are provided with fruit). There will be no toast for key stage 2 available to buy at this time. Please note: children should not bring their own hand sanitiser into school.
Lunch Bags/Boxes		Lunches can be sent to school in a plastic or material lunch box/bag.
Personal Items (games, money, toys, pencil cases, mobile phones, presents for other children)		No unnecessary items should be brought into school (unless prior permission has been granted). Money will not be needed as toast will not be available at this time. Children in Year 5 and 6 are only permitted to bring mobile phones if they walk home and must gain permission from class teachers, who will then store the phones during the school day. Please email Miss Burt (Year 5) or Mr Kay (Year 6) to arrange this.
Water Bottles		All children should have a full water bottle with them each day. Please ensure that these are named so that duplicated bottles are not mixed up between children.
Coats and other outdoor clothing		Children should have a named, waterproof coat with them every day. Gloves, hats, scarves etc are permitted if it is cold but please ensure that these are clearly named.
PE Kit/ Bags		At this time, children will not need PE kits in school. Instead, your child will be expected to attend school in their PE kit on their PE day (white t-shirt and black shorts/jogging bottoms), trainers or pumps and their school jumper or cardigan. No tracksuits or hoodies will be permitted.
Face Masks/ Coverings (for adults only)		When dropping off and collecting children from school, all adults should wear face masks/coverings when moving around the school grounds. Please note: Children should not bring face masks/covering into school.
