Letter 35 – Monday 1st March 2021


Dear Children

So, this is our last week of remote learning! Only five days left. Let's have one last push to do our best home learning. Zara certainly worked hard in her home last week.


She produced some incredible English work. First, she wrote a fantastic set of clear instructions. Then she followed them to make an amazing rocket!
