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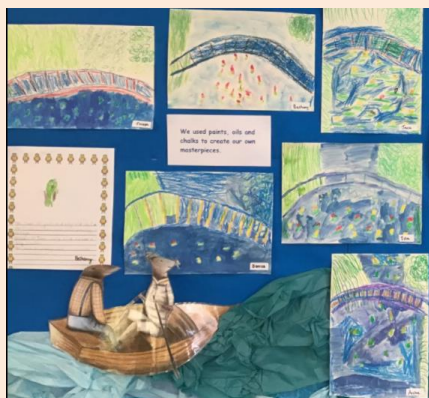
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Wind in the Willows ...

We would hugely appreciate any donations and they

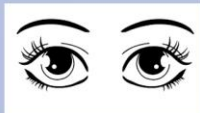

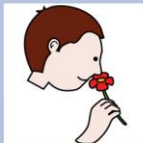
MindUp
