Sports for Champions

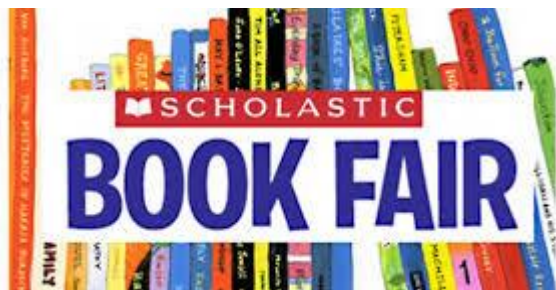
