Healthy Lunchboxes





We are keen to help our children understand what a healthy diet consists of and to support them in developing good eating habits.

The Eatwell Guide, encourages a lunchbox to contain:

- a starchy food, e.g. potatoes, bread, rice, pasta;
- plenty of fruit and vegetables, e.g. carrot sticks, an apple, sliced cucumber;
- a source of protein, e.g. beans, pulses, egg, fish, meat;
- a healthy drink, e.g. water, semi-skimmed milk.

We have noticed that some lunch boxes contain no fruit or vegetables. Please try and include 1 or 2 fruit or veg items. Chocolate bars and sweets are not suitable for lunch boxes please keep these for a treat at home.



'A Day to Remember' is aimed at children aged 3-7 to introduce the significance of Remembrance Day. It takes into account the EYFS Development Matters (2021) and National Curriculum making it an educational tool to support children's historical skills, knowledge and curiosity. Learning elements include:

Discussing language such as "courageous" and "brave"

Empathy - Putting yourself in a soldiers shoes

Comparisons of past and present

Chronology - People in illustrations wearing different clothing to that that we see today. What else has changed?
