



We have had a really positive start to the new year in school with children eager to start their new topics of learning. I also had the pleasure of taking the Year 2 and 3 children who have earned 50 Golden Ticks for a Hot Chocolate treat today. This is part of our reward system that the children helped to develop in the autumn term.



Golden Ticks are earned by the children for diligent work, demonstration of good manners, a kind nature and living the school values. A maximum of 2 ticks can be earned at any one time. This system is in place from Year 2 to Year 6. Rewards are given when a child reaches different milestones:

25 Golden Ticks – earns an extra break

50 Golden Ticks – a hot chocolate with Head/Deputy

75 Golden Ticks - Non-uniform day

100 Golden ticks – Enrichment afternoon
