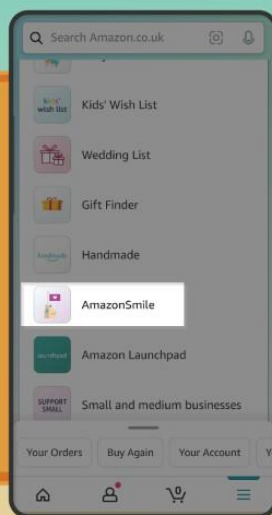

Crossing Patrol

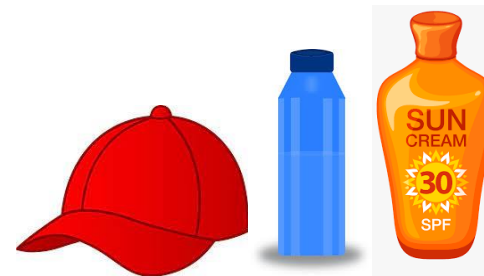
Lancashire County Council have apologised for the lack of a crossing patrol on Back Lane as they are having difficulty recruiting a replacement.
