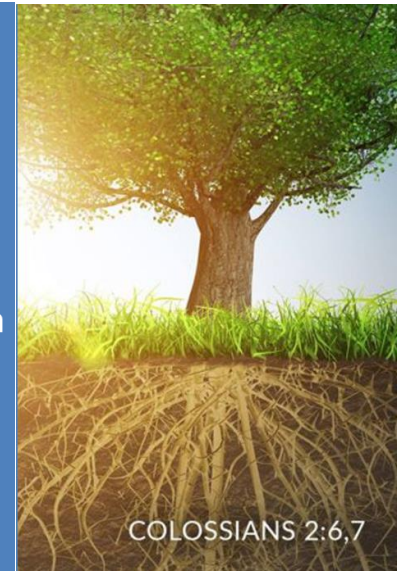


## Extra-curricular Opportunities

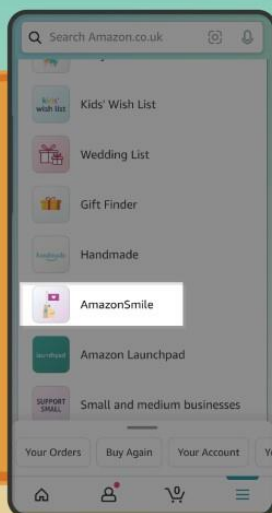
