We thought about how important it is to find out about different traditions and festivals.

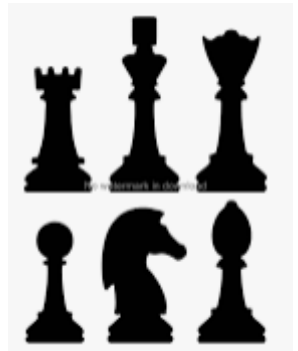
