Ready for summer weather

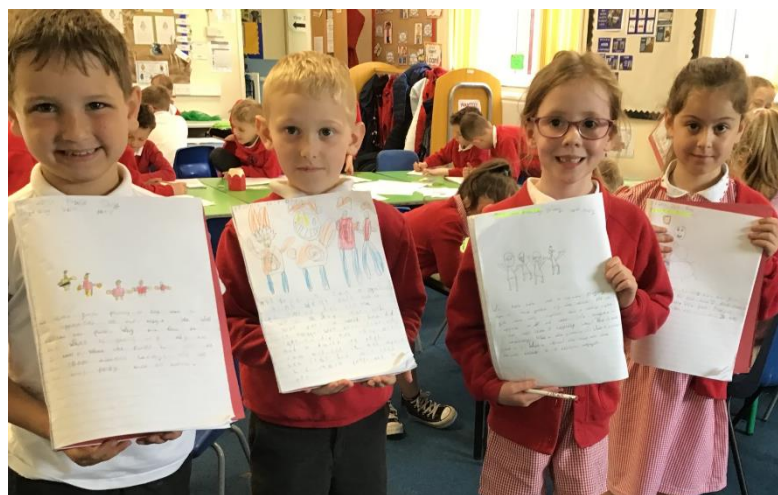
Please remember to send in named sun hats/caps and to apply sun cream before school as the weather gets warmer.
